

Rules for the Wisconsin State Association Golf Outing

1. This tournaments shall be held on the 3rd Saturday in July
2. Play will be a standard scramble format while running both scratch and handicap (Peoria) flights simultaneously.
Scramble definition:
Each team's players hit from the tee box. The team members then choose the best of the four shots for their next shot. All team members must drop their balls within one club length, without advancing towards the hole, and then play their second shot from that location. They again choose the best shot. Play continues in this manner until the hole is completed. The team then records its score and maintains that format for all 18 holes.
3. Team structure can be that of all men, or all women, or any mixed combination of.
4. Men will play white tees, women red tees, and seniors (62+) gold tees.
5. A tiebreaker will be used in the event two or more teams marked the lowest score after 18holes. Using the handicap row on the scorecard, the tying team's scores will be compared. Starting with the most difficult rated hole (1 and then working your way down 2,3,4,etc...) the first team whose marked score is lower than the other(s) will be declared the winner.
6. First place prizes for both the scratch and handicap categories will be of equal value.
7. The team that finishes in first place for the Scratch category is not eligible for the Handicap category.
8. The host lodge will be responsible for the cost of plate engraving of the provided Moose State traveling trophies.
9. Entry fee will cover at a minimum:
 - a) Green fees + ½ cart
 - b) Lunch on course (minimum of : 1 sandwich (brat or burger) and 1 beverage (amount equal to 1 can of adult brewed draft)
 - c) Dinner
 - d) Prize fees (includes rule #6 & #8)
